









Kijang Economics Competition (Kijang) is a national economics competition for primary schools, secondary schools and pre-university students which aims to challenge students' economics knowledge through financial mathematics, economics, entrepreneurship, financial literacy and business. The competition will take place in August 2022.

Kijang intends to spark a competitive nature among students by providing them with the opportunity to polish and develop in economy and financial literacy. Kijang's questions have a unique way of highlighting economy and financial concepts by relating it to the local and global economies over time.

Kijang consists of multiple choice questions (tests), requiring an application of economics and financial knowledge to find solutions on capital resources, use of financial instruments and financial market analysis.

Kijang Economics Competition has three categories which is sorted by age groups; namely as **Primary**, **Lower Secondary** and **Upper Secondary**.

- To stimulate the significant use of economics skills in the area of human endeavour especially as a way to solve national problems.

- Questions in Kijang are drawn from real-life situations and contemporary issues in order to stimulate students' problem-solving and critical thinking ability.
- Kijang's syllabus incorporates the Malaysian school syllabus, which makes Kijang a significant economics competition that is suitable to almost all students in Malaysia.
- Kijang is catered to all school students from Year 1 to Form 6 & Pre-University as it has three different categories with differing levels of difficulty.
- Kijang's questions are designed and reviewed by education professionals.





In 2020, there are 870 students have participated in the Kijang Economics Competition. Out of 870 participants, 73 winners from the Upper and Lower Secondary category were chosen to participate in the Malaysian Economics Olympiad (MyEO) 2021. The five top scorers from MyEO 2021 were selected to represent Malaysia at the 4th International Economics Olympiad (IEO) 2021. The event was held virtually by the hosting country Riga, Latvia. It is completely organized by The University of Latvia. The Malaysian team made the country proud by winning 1 gold medal, 3 silver medal and 1 bronze medal. IEO was funded by the Bank of Latvia and completely managed by University of Latvia, National Center for Education of Latvia, SEB, LMT and Higher School of Economics (HSE) Moscow, Russia. IEO was participated by 215 high school students from 44 countries.

There are 749 students have participated in the Kijang Economics Competition 2021. 68 top scorers have been invited to participate in the Malaysian Economics Olympiad (MyEO) 2022. It was a one-day contest that covers all economics and financial aspects.
