

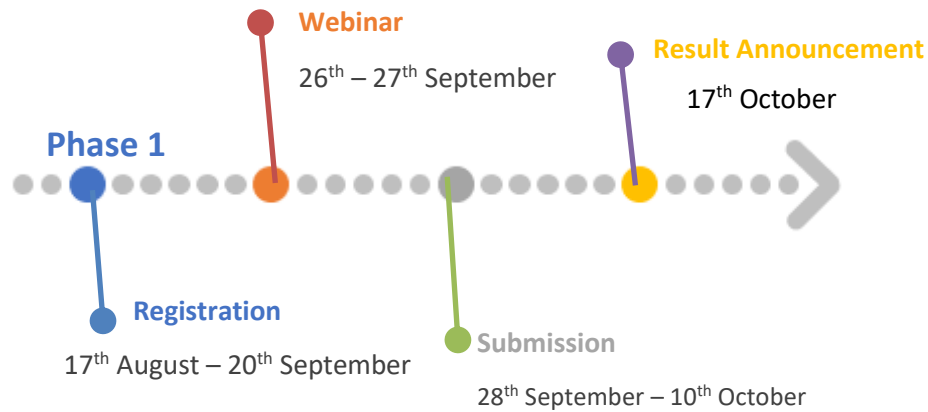

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Rules & Regulations

1. Theme Context
 - 1.1. Participants are required to come up with a device, a technology or a system that will be beneficial to a specific community in need to help improve their quality of lives. The specific community within the above context refers to a community of people that require extra assistance to help them to improve their quality of lives.
 - 1.2. For the context of our competition, the form of “help” provided to these communities must be physical and can be designed into a model. The proposed idea must be interactable and provide physical assistance to the chosen community. The proposed idea must also fulfil one of the sustainable goals listed below:
 1. SDG 3: Good Health and Well Being
 2. SDG 6: Clean Water and Sanitization
 3. SDG 7: Affordable and Clean Energy
 - 1.3. Each team will be randomly assigned with one specific topic during the webinar which falls under any of the 3 SDC listed above.

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2. Registration/ Team Eligibility :
 - 2.1. Multiple teams are allowed from one secondary school.
 - 2.2. Team members in one team are allowed to be in different schools (not limited to the same school).
 - 2.3. A complete team consists of **3-5** students and **1** teacher-in-charge(optional):
 - a. Any secondary school students
 - b. Teacher-in-charge (optional): Any teacher from a secondary school.
 - c. Teams and teacher-in-charge (optional) must be fluent in English.
 - d. Team leaders or teachers-in-charge (optional) must have access to the Internet and an active email in order to communicate with HOPE UTP 4.0 Public Relation (PR) Department.
 - 2.4. All participants and teacher-in-charges (optional) who wish to participate must register and have a complete team prior to the close of registration.
 - 2.5. All registration must be done **before 20th September 2020** 11:59pm.
 - 2.6. Teams may not add or drop participants after registration is closed.
 - 2.7. All required fields in the registration form must be completed.
3. Selection/ Judging Process
 - 3.1. Two webinars will be conducted online via **Microsoft Teams (MST)** on **26th and 27th September 2020**. All participants and teacher-in-charge (optional) of each team must participate in the webinars.
 - 3.2. After the webinars, HOPE UTP 4.0 expects to receive **1** entry submission from each team:
 - a. Poster proposal
 - 3.3. Poster Proposal
 - a. Create a poster on the problem given, its significance/ urgency, proposed solution or any other relevant information.
 - b. The created poster will serve as the proposal for the concept idea.





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- c. Poster work may begin any time after 27th September 2020 - 9th October 2020.
 - d. Poster submission deadline: **10th October 2020 11:59pm.**
- 4. General Rules & Regulations:
 - 4.1. English will be the main medium of language for the event.
 - 4.2. Each team member must make significant contributions to the success of the team and be a full participant in the team.
 - 4.3. Teams are encouraged to seek guidance or advice from teacher-in-charge, parents, friends, published sources, and the Internet, team members must do their work on their own.
 - 4.4. By participating in this competition, participants agree to be bound by this Contest Rules & Regulations, and the decisions of HOPE UTP 4.0
 - 4.5. By submitting the entries, the producers and owners of the entries are to grant the Organizer exclusive rights of the copyright to use the entries or material submitted for documentation or promotional.
- 5. Uses of copyrighted materials:
 - 5.1. Participants confirm that they are legal and/or beneficial owners or otherwise have the intellectual property rights to submit such materials; and therefore warrant that they have obtained rights in incorporating copyrighted materials i.e. graphic and images in the poster entry. Each entry and any part thereof shall not at any time violate any laws or the right of third party.
 - 5.2. Participants shall confirm that entries submitted do not include any illegal or unauthorized copy of another person's copyrighted or copyrightable work, including, but not limited to
 - a. Pirated computer programs or links to them,
 - b. Information which circumvents manufacturer-installed copy-protect devices,
 - c. Copyrighted materials or links to copyrighted files
 - 5.3. An entry may include supporting materials that were created by another person if an accurate citation of the quoted materials is included in the entry. If citations are not included, this will be considered as plagiarism. Plagiarism will result in the team disqualification.
 - 5.4. Quotations from printed materials such as newspapers, magazines or books are permissible if an accurate citation is used.





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- 5.5. No entry may include any trademarked material(s) without the written permission from the owner(s) of the trademarked materials.





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6. Result Announcement:

- 6.1. The top **three** teams will be announced in the closing ceremony on **17th October 2020**.
- 6.2. All participants are highly encouraged to join the closing ceremony.
- 6.3. Presentation videos of the winners will be showcased during the announcement.
- 6.4. 3 consolation prize winners will be announced:
 - a. Consolation Prize (1)
 - b. Consolation Prize (2)
 - c. Consolation Prize (Best social media award)
 - d. All results will be published on HOPE UTP 4.0 social media platforms along the presentation videos of the winners.

7. Prizes

- 7.1. All participants including teacher-in-charge (optional) will receive an **e-certificate** of participations via email after 17th October 2020.
