

Annex A - ASEAN Undergraduate Scholarship Nomination/Eligibility Criteria and Terms & Conditions

Nomination/Eligibility Criteria

1. Nominees must be citizens of an ASEAN member country (except Singapore).
2. Nominees should be completing either of the following academic qualifications by AY2017:
 - Cambridge 'A' Levels (must have 4 'A' Level subjects)
 - Australian High School (Australian Capital Territory Exam, New South Wales HSC, Queensland Certificate of Education, South Australian Certificate of Education/Matriculation, Victoria Certificate of Education or Western Australia Certificate of Education)
 - Sijil Tinggi Persekolahan Malaysia (STPM) (must have 4 Principle Level subjects, including Pengajian Am)
 - Unified Examination Certificate (UEC) (must have 6 subjects, including English Language and a second language)
 - International Baccalaureate (IB) Diploma (must have 3 HL & 3 SL subjects, TOK & EE)
3. Nominees should possess outstanding academic results, excellent records of participation in non-academic activities, good leadership track records, and fulfil one of the following English Language requirements:
 - C6 or better for EL1119 or 'O' Level English
 - 200 or better for MUET
 - 580 or better for TOEFL (paper-based) or 92-93 for TOEFL (internet-based)
 - 6.5 or better for IELTS (both 6.5 in Reading and Writing components)

Terms & Conditions

4. The scholarship covers tuition fees (remaining sum after the Singapore Ministry of Education (MOE) Tuition Grant Subsidy) and provides an annual living allowance of S\$5,800.
5. The scholarship does not carry a bond. However, tuition fees at NUS are subsidised through the MOE Tuition Grant Subsidy and the portion of the tuition fees covered under the MOE Tuition Grant Subsidy is not covered under the scholarship. AUS recipients are required to take up the MOE Tuition Grant Subsidy, which requires recipients to complete a bond of three years (for all non-Medicine/Dentistry courses) by working with a Singapore-registered company of their choice. Students in Medicine and Dentistry are required to complete bond periods of six and five years respectively.
6. The scholarship is applicable for studies in one of the following undergraduate courses:
 - Architecture
 - Arts and Social Sciences
 - Business Administration
 - Business Administration (Accountancy)
 - Computer Engineering (jointly offered by the Faculty of Engineering & School of Computing)
 - Computing (including Business Analytics, Computer Science Courses, Information Security, Information Systems)
 - Data Science and Analytics

- Engineering courses (including Biomedical, Chemical, Civil, Electrical, Engineering Science, Environmental, Industrial & Systems Engineering, Materials Science & Engineering, Mechanical)
- Environmental Studies
- Industrial Design
- Nursing
- Pharmacy
- Project & Facilities Management
- Real Estate
- Science
- Dentistry*
- Law*
- Medicine*

** Please note that Dentistry, Law and Medicine courses are highly competitive and there are very limited scholarships available for these courses.*

7. The scholarship offer and award are subject to the following conditions:
- The candidate applies for and is admitted to NUS for Academic Year 2017/2018. (Please note that admission to NUS is strictly based on merit and candidates for the scholarship do not receive automatic admission or preferential treatment for admission.)
 - The recipient is certified medically fit for the scholarship by a medical authority appointed by the Scholarships Board.
 - The recipient is issued a visa and subsequently a Student's Pass by the Singapore Government to pursue the course of study in Singapore.
 - The recipient will take up the course of study offered in the first offer of admission. The scholarship offer/award will be reviewed if the recipient wishes to alter the course of study after accepting the first offer of admission.
 - The recipient is NOT concurrently holding any other scholarship, fellowship, grant or award without the prior approval of the University.
 - The recipient's academic performance and conduct for each year of the course is maintained at a satisfactory level to justify continuation of the scholarship. The University reserves the right to suspend or terminate the scholarship if the recipient's academic performance or conduct is unsatisfactory (e.g. Cumulative Average Point of below 3.5).
