Applicants with no Korean language skills can be accepted to the International Trade Management Track of the Division of International Studies which offers all courses in English. Those who hold a TOPIK (Test of Proficiency in Korean) certificate higher than level 3 are eligible for admission to any majors in the undergraduate programs. All international students at BUFS are offered beginners' and intermediate Korean language courses.
