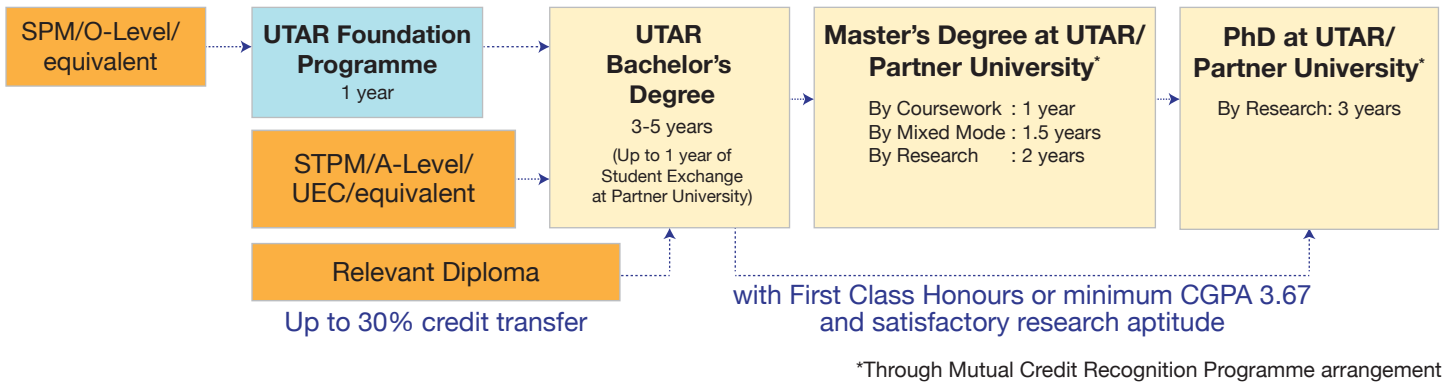

# Minimum Entry Requirements

## (I) Academic Requirements

The minimum entry requirements listed are for general reference only. These requirements may vary with programmes and subject to the latest requirements set by the Ministry of Higher Education (MOHE) or Malaysian Qualifications Agency (MQA) and any related Professional Bodies.

### Foundation Programmes

#### Foundation in Arts

- SPM/O-Level: Grade C in 5 relevant subjects
- UEC: Grade B in 3 relevant subjects
- Other recognised equivalent qualifications

#### Foundation in Science

- SPM/O-Level: Grade C in 5 relevant subjects including Mathematics and 2 Science subjects (except M.B.B.S.)
- UEC: Grade B in Mathematics and 2 Science subjects
- Other recognised equivalent qualifications

### Undergraduate Programmes

- UTAR Foundation Programme
- STPM: Grade C/C+ in 2 relevant subjects depending on the programmes (except M.B.B.S. and Quantity Surveying)
- A-Level: Grade D in 2 or 3 relevant subjects
- UEC: Grade B in 5 relevant subjects
- SAM: ATAR 70 and Grade B in at least 2 relevant subjects
- CPU: An average of 70% in 6 relevant subjects (depending on programmes)

## (III) Chinese Language Requirements (Only Applicable to Chinese Studies Programmes)

Applicants for Chinese Studies programmes shall also possess a recognised test score or a letter from the institution's Registrar if Chinese was the sole medium of instruction in their previous qualification. Scan to check the Chinese Language requirements.

### Accreditation for Prior Experiential Learning (APEL)

Applicants (without a formal qualification) with at least 21 years of age and relevant work experience can apply for APEL for Access [APEL.A] on the MQA website and receive the APEL.A Certificate to enrol in relevant undergraduate programmes at UTAR. Registered students of part-time undergraduate programmes may apply for APEL for Credit Award [APEL.C] with their work experience and short courses attended before. Successful applicants will be

### Credit Transfer

Applicants with prior formal study are welcome to join UTAR's programmes with credit transfer. Credit transfer will be granted based on student's previous academic achievements obtained at another local/foreign institution of higher learning.
